GOALS FOR 2023 IS \$90,000 (WITH MATCHING \$45,000 St. DAVID'S FUNDS)

Brief History

In 2012, several WHO members, Neighborhoods 43 and 39 read an article in the Williamson Sun Newspaper stating that Opportunities for Williams & Burnet Counties/MOW (OWBC) had a waiting list for Sun City and Georgetown clients. We were shocked by this article and decided to take action. WHO took charge and decided 1) to have a fundraiser; 2) to involve the NRO because the fundraiser was Sun City wide; and 3) to feed these individuals while we were raising money. Opportunities, Director of Senior Nutrition was contacted to get the names and addresses of those on the waiting list. Because of the HIPPA Laws, this information could not be given out; however, the MOW Director volunteered to call each and every one of these individuals to get their approval for WHO to contact them and deliver a meal. About nine individuals responded. WHO guickly got a team together and almost immediately started delivering meals. The expression of gratitude was overwhelming from these seniors. The MOW/WHO alliance was formed and the goal "to never have a waiting list again" was established. The Development Team of OWBC was responsible for obtaining the matching funds from St. David's Foundation in 2016. The matching funds have increased from \$10,000 in 2016 to \$45,000 for 2023. St. David's has become aware and recognizes "The WHO Ladies" for their outstanding fundraising skills.
